Jan 4 to Feb 10 E158 - E118	<u>Signatures in Lieu of Filing Fee</u> <i>Judicial Offices of the Superior Court Only</i>
Jan 4 to Feb 25 E158 - E103	<u>Signatures in Lieu of Filing Fee</u> U.S. Congressional and <i>all other Candidates.</i>
Feb 1 to Feb 10 E127 - E118	<u>Declaration of Intention</u> <i>Judicial Offices of the Superior Court Only</i>
Feb 11 to Feb 16 E117 - E113	<u>Extension Period for Declaration of Intention</u> If incumbent does not file, the filing period for <i>Judicial Offices of the Superior Court</i> is extended.
Feb 16 to Mar 12 E113 - E88	<u>Declaration of Candidacy and Nomination Papers</u> Candidate filing period for ALL elective offices.
Mar 13 to Mar 17 E87 - E83	<u>Extension Period for Declaration of Candidacy and Nomination Papers</u> If incumbent does not file, the filing period is extended for all other candidates.

Please Note: ***Judicial candidates of the Superior Court must pay their filing fee when their Declaration of Intention is filed between February 1, 2010 and February 10, 2010.***

All other candidates must pay their filing fee when pulling their Nomination Papers.
