OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING LAKE TAHOE
RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL
AS LEAD AGENCY

WHEREAS, monies for erosion control in the Tahoe Basin are now available under the Santini-Burton Act; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada Tahoe Conservation District and the Tahoe Resource Conservation District are mandated by State law of both Nevada and California to protect the water quality of Lake Tahoe and control erosion; and

WHEREAS, the Conservation Districts have demonstrated abilities to design, manage and complete erosion control through on-the-ground projects; and

WHEREAS, the Lake Tahoe Resource Conservation and Development Council is comprised of representatives from each County, the City of South Lake Tahoe, and both Conservation Districts, and can coordinate and set priorities for erosion control projects;

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado, State of California, does support the concept of designating the Lake Tahoe Resource Conservation and Development Council as the lead agency for erosion control projects in the Tahoe Basin.
