WHEREAS, the County of El Dorado desires to undertake attendance at the Graduate Criminal Law Seminar to be funded in part from funds made available through the Omnibus Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 administered by the California Council on Criminal Justice,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that WILLIAM E. BYRNE, Judge of the El Dorado County Superior Court, is authorized to submit the attached Application for Grant for Law Enforcement Purposes to the California Council on Criminal Justice for its consideration; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in the event the California Council on Criminal Justice consents to fund the project, WILLIAM E. BYRNE is authorized to execute on behalf of the County of El Dorado the contract for the grant for law enforcement purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the applicant agrees to provide the required matching funds to said project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant ongoing law enforcement expenditures.
