RESOLUTION No. 1-74

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, portions of Mt. Aukum Road No. 78 have been superseded by the relocation of said road; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado has determined that the abandonment of such portions of the Mt. Aukum Road No. 78 will not cut off access to the property of any person which, prior to the relocation, adjoined the highway,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado that, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 960.1 and 960.2 of the Streets and Highways Code, the portions of the old Mt. Aukum Road shown as shaded areas outside the right-of-way boundaries of the Mt. Aukum Road No. 78 on the map dated December 10, 1973, entitled "Abandonment of Superseded Portions of Mt. Aukum Road No. 78" attached to this Resolution and marked Exhibit "A" be, and the same are, hereby abandoned, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to record a certified copy of this resolution pursuant to Section 960.2 of the Streets and Highways Code.
