



RESOLUTION NO. 015-2009

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, following approval of Senate Bill 1396, signed into law by Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger, county supervisors are allowed to increase real estate document fees from Two Dollars and no/100 (\$2.00) to Three Dollars and no/100 (\$3.00) in an effort to provide adequate resources to the district attorney's office and local law enforcement to investigate and prosecute Real Estate Fraud.

WHEREAS, all funds raised through this increase in real estate document fees will be placed in the Real Estate Fraud Prosecution Trust Fund according to the provisions of Government Code Section 27388.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the increase in real estate document fees from Two Dollars and no/100 (\$2.00) to Three Dollars and no/100 (\$3.00) pursuant to the passage of Senate Bill 1396.
