RESOLUTION No. 15-79

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

CONCURRING IN THE FINDING OF THE GOLD TRAIL UNION SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT THE DISTRICT IS OVERCROWDED AND ESTABLISHING A FEE APPLICABLE TO THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS TO TEMPORARILY ALLEVIATE IMPACTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of El Dorado County previously adopted Chapter 6 (commencing with Section 10800) of Part 10 of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code as authorized by Sections 65970, et seq., of the Government Code relating to impacted schools; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Gold Trail Union School District has submitted a Resolution declaring Gold Trail Union School District an impacted school district, and other information and data showing that conditions of overcrowding exist in the district; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed the findings of the Governing Board of the Gold Trail Union School District and also finds that the District Board has made reasonable efforts to mitigate the conditions of overcrowding; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Gold Trail Union School District has submitted justification and request for the fees set forth below, now therefore be it

RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of El Dorado County that while conditions of overcrowding continue to exist, each developer within the boundaries of the Gold Trail Union School District shall enter into an agreement with the Gold Trail Union School District providing for a satisfactory temporary alternative to permanent school construction or

shall pay the fees prior to the issuance of a building permit, as prescribed in Section 10800, et seq., of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code pursuant to the following schedule:

1 Bedroom Dwelling Unit	\$200.00
2 Bedroom Dwelling Unit	300.00
3 Bedroom Dwelling Unit	400.00
4 Bedroom or More Dwelling Unit	500.00
Mobilehome	300.00 per mobilehome pad.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective at the start of the business day on January 10, 1979.
