RESOLUTION NO. 17-79

OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF EL DORADO COUNTY
SANITATION DISTRICT NO. 2 MAKING APPLICATION
FOR THE DISSOLUTION OF SAID DISTRICT AND TRANSFER
OF FUNCTIONS TO THE EL DORADO IRRIGATION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of El Dorado County Sanitation District No. 2 has determined that the public interest would be best served by having the El Dorado Irrigation District responsible for providing sewer services in the area served by El Dorado County Sanitation District No. 2 and that El Dorado Irrigation District has been providing the operation and maintenance for County Sanitation District No. 2; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of El Dorado County Sanitation District No. 2 desires to initiate a proceeding for the dissolution of said district pursuant to the District Reorganization Act of 1965 (Sections 56000 et seq., Government Code) upon condition that the El Dorado Irrigation District accept all assets and liabilities and responsibility for operation and maintenance of El Dorado County Sanitation District No. 2; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the El Dorado County Sanitation District No. 2 hereby requests that the Local Agency Formation Commission consider the dissolution of El Dorado County Sanitation District No. 2, subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. That the Board of Supervisors be named the conducting entity in accordance with law.
2. That the El Dorado Irrigation District be designated, and accept all responsibilities as, successor to El Dorado County Sanitation District No. 2.

1 3. That all property, real and personal, of El Dorado County
2 Sanitation District No. 2 be transferred to the El Dorado Irrigation
3 District as successor district.

4 4. That all funds of El Dorado County Sanitation District
5 No. 2, including cash on hand and monies due but uncollected, and
6 other obligations due the El Dorado County Sanitation District No. 2
7 be transferred to the El Dorado Irrigation District.

8 5. That El Dorado Irrigation District as successor district
9 succeed to all of the rights, duties and obligations of El Dorado
10 County Sanitation District No. 2 with respect to the enforcement,
11 performance or payment of any outstanding bonds or other contracts
12 and obligations of El Dorado County Sanitation District No. 2, and
13 that the El Dorado Irrigation District as successor district, be
14 specifically authorized to issue and sell authorized but unissued
15 bonds of the El Dorado County Sanitation District No. 2.

16 6. That the El Dorado Irrigation District be authorized to
17 impose upon the territory now served by El Dorado County Sanitation
18 District No. 2 liability for payment of all principal, interest and
19 any other amounts which shall become due on account of any outstand-
20 ing or presently authorized but hereafter issued bonds or other
21 contracts or obligations of El Dorado County Sanitation District
22 No. 2 and the levying or fixing and the collection of any taxes or
23 assessments or service charges or rates or both in the same manner
24 as provided in the original authorization of the bonds and in the
25 amount necessary to provide for such payment.

26 7. That the effective date of the dissolution of El Dorado
27 County Sanitation District No. 2 and assumption of rights, duties
28 and obligations by the El Dorado Irrigation District as successor

1 district be at 5:00 o'clock p.m. on June 30, 1979.
