



RESOLUTION No. 21-89

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

RESOLUTION FORMING RIDGEVIEW VILLAGE ESTATES DRAINAGE ZONE #51, OF COUNTY SERVICE AREA #9, TO PROVIDE DRAINAGE FACILITY MAINTENANCE SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado has formed County Service Area #9 pursuant to Title 3, Division 2, Part 2, Chapter 2.2 of the California Government Code; and

WHEREAS, this Board may establish zones of benefit within any county service area to provide extended services including, but not limited to drainage facility maintenance; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and adopted a series of policies relating to the formation and administration of zones of benefit within a county service area; and

WHEREAS, a complete application has been submitted requesting the formation of a zone of benefit to provide drainage facility maintenance within the boundaries of County Service Area #9; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the formation of the zone of benefit has been duly noticed and held before this Board and no significant level of protest was made against the formation of Zone #51.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors hereby resolves and determines as follows:

1. The Ridgeview Village Estates Drainage Zone #51 of County Service Area #9 is hereby formed with the boundaries of said zone to be those described in Exhibit A attached hereto and shown on Exhibit B, also attached hereto.
2. That the purpose of such formation is to provide certain drainage facility maintenance throughout the affected area.
3. That funding for the provision of services throughout the benefit zone shall come from a benefit assessment collected through the tax roll from properties within the zone that benefit from the services to be rendered.

4. That the formation shall be governed by and comply with the policies and procedures relating to establishing, operating and regulating zones of benefit within CSA #9.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is to be recorded and filed with the State Board of Equalization after the final map is approved and the drainage easements are dedicated to the County.
