# RESOLUTION No. 29-89

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO JOINT RESOLUTION WITH EL DORADO COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO EXPEDITIOUSLY FILL JUDICIAL VACANCIES

WHEREAS, El Dorado County Superior Courts consist of three (3) Superior Courts, and

WHEREAS, unprecedented rapid growth in population is occurring in El Dorado County and the County's justice system is likewise experiencing a tremendous increase in case load, and

WHEREAS, two (2) out of the three (3) current Superior Court Judges have announced their retirements in the immediate future and by April 30, 1989, two-thirds (2/3) of the Superior Court judgeships will be vacant, and

WHEREAS, the Board and the Court are seriously concerned over the potential negative impact the forecasted judicial vacancies will have on the proper and the efficient administration of justice within the Superior Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, the El Dorado County Superior Courts and the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors do jointly resolve to express their concerns over these matters and request the Governor to expeditiously appoint and fill the judicial vacancies.
