

Parcel Number Change Information

El Dorado County recently changed from its old mainframe system to a more current, cost-effect server-based system called Megabyte. This new system is helping to streamline the preparation and administration of property tax information between County departments.

As a result, some changes to property tax bills were necessitated. One change was to Parcel Numbers. Under the Megabyte system, your Parcel Number (or APN) is now called "Assessment Number" and "Fee Parcel Number." Also, it must contain 12 digits where County APNs had always consisted of 11 digits.

If you know your old APN, you can easily find your new Fee Parcel Number:

Old APN:	116	030	09	100
Fee Parcel #:	116	030	009	000

Simply add a "0" before the former 2-digit number and replace the ending "100" with "000."

Now, you can enter this number at <https://common3.mptsweb.com/MBC/eldorado/tax/search> to view and pay your property taxes on-line.

If your parcel number ended in a number other than 100, and/or if you do not know your old APN, visit the Assessor's website to look up your new Fee Parcel Number: www.edcgov.us/Government/Assessor to look up your parcel number.

If you are still unable to find your assessment number you still have options. You can actually search by your street address. To search by street address select the down arrow under "Search By" and select Street Address (Do not include St, Ave, Dr, Etc). You can now add your street number and street name. This will provide you with your property tax information. Please see the image below.
