EL DORADO COUNTY IS IMPLEMENTING LANE SHIFTS & CLOSURES ON MISSOURI FLAT ROAD BETWEEN OLD DEPOT ROAD AND PLEASANT VALLEY ROAD TO INSTALL UNDERGROUND UTILITIES

February through July 2022

(PLACERVILLE, CA) – Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) is performing utility work along Missouri Flat Road between Old Depot Road and Pleasant Valley Road and will continue through July 2022. The work involves relocating overhead electric and communication lines to underground facilities and removal of over 20 utility poles along the Missouri Flat Road corridor. This work is necessary to begin future roadway, drainage, and signalization improvements on Missouri Flat Road at the intersections with Industrial Drive and Enterprise Drive next year.

The utility work will require lane shifts using the center turn lane in order to complete underground utility trench installation work. Additionally, occasional lane closures during night hours will also be required at specific locations.

Motorists are advised to slow down through the work zone and expect delays during construction hours, Monday through Friday, between 6:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Motorists are also advised to allow extra time when traveling through the work zone in order to arrive at their destinations on time or use alternate routes to avoid the construction area.

The County sincerely appreciates the cooperation and patience of motorists that use this roadway and we apologize for any inconvenience as a result of this work.
