**CALTRANS TO PERFORM ROAD WORK**

**PONDORADO ROAD FOR US 50 CAMINO SAFETY PROJECT**

**ROAD CLOSURE FROM AUGUST 8, 2023 THROUGH AUGUST 9, 2023**

August 1, 2023

**(PLACERVILLE, CA)** – In partnership with El Dorado County’s Department of Transportation, Caltrans performed road work on US 50 and local roads in the Camino area that began in late 2020 and continued through late 2022, to construct a new median barrier and undercrossing.

The new Pondorado roadway alignment to the new undercrossing was completed, but a small segment from Golden Chain Drive to School Drive is planned for pavement repairs. Pondorado Road will need to be reconstructed between these two intersections. Traffic control signs will be installed to detour traffic to US 50 around this Pondorado Road closure. Caltrans has requested a full closure of Pondorado Road between Golden Chain Drive and School Drive, due to public safety and to shorten the duration of traffic impacts to the public. The full closure of this segment of Pondorado Road is scheduled to take place from **6:00 am on August 8, 2023 through 5:00 pm on August 9, 2023.**

Motorists are advised to slow down through the work zone and expect delays during this construction period. Motorists are also advised to allow extra time when traveling around the work zone in order to arrive at their destinations on time. Businesses located on Pondorado Road will have limited access during this time, and emergency access will be accommodated as needed. Alternative routes during this closure include US 50, Carson Road, US 50 Exit 49B, and US 50 Exit 54.

The County sincerely appreciates the cooperation and patience of motorists who use this roadway, and we apologize for any inconvenience as a result of these closures.
