Please accept this memo as a weekly update to the activities surrounding the County of El Dorado's recovery from the Caldor Fire as managed by the Recovery Operations Center's (ROC) co-directors Sgt. Moke Auwae and me.

Environmental Management

Alternate Program

- 30 applications & 30 work plans submitted
- 27 work plans approved
- 17 properties cleaned and sampled
- 12 parcel owners have completed the program; 10 in Grizzly Flats, 2 in Twin Bridges

Alternate Program completion date extended to June 1, 2022.

Public Program

- 414 completed Full ROE final sign off*
- 108 Tree only final sign off

Health and Human Services Agency

- Better Together Long Term Recovery Group (LTRG)
 - Chairpersons Approved: Amy Mefford, Jennifer McKim-Hibbard, and Scott Telfer to share chairing duties and responsibilities.
 - Bylaws and procedures were presented to General Committee to review and comment at a later date.
 - Kelly Jordan, County Libraries, was approved as Secretary.
- Case Management
 - 11 open cases
 - All level 5 cases have been assisted
 - Bricquel Smith is Salvation Army's new Disaster Case Management worker.
 - Salvation Army's Camp Del Oro is offering 25 scholarships (\$25 rather than \$300) to children affected by the Caldor fire.
- Unmet Needs
 - 10 committed funders to support unmet needs, 10 or so potential funders have expressed interest
 - Most of their cases have been handled by allocations because they've been under \$5k.
- The Emotional/Spiritual Wellness Committee is starting to plan an anniversary event.
- Distribution event 6/12/22
 - New tier system. Priority entry (12:00pm – 1:00pm) for anyone who had 50% or more damage to home. Less than 50% or evacuated entry from 1:00pm – 3:00pm.
 - 2 new referrals
 - Distribution event 7/17/22 will focus on school supplies
