



AGRICULTURAL GRADING APPLICATION CHECK LIST

***Every line of the two page application must be completed or have an "N/A".**

EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PLANS:

- Site plan map must be submitted showing the following:
 - Existing roads,
 - Existing buildings,
 - Existing water bodies (ponds, streams, rivers, etc.),
 - Topographic lines,
 - Flow lines of surface water onto and off the site,
 - Location of agricultural grading site,
 - The perimeter boundary of the grading site and crop layout, including row spacing, row direction, and terraces, if any,
 - Location and boundaries of all soil types,
 - Required setbacks from any designated streams or waterways,
 - Location of vegetation that will remain undisturbed by the grading,
 - Location of all soil protection measures (mulching, cover crops, and other surface stabilization measures),
 - Location of all storm water management and sediment control measures (drainage swales, berms, filter strips, silt fencing, sediment basins, channels, drop inlets, etc.)

- A written description of the best management practices to be used must include the following:
 - Temporary and permanent best management practices,
 - A schedule for implementation, maintenance, and upkeep of erosion and sediment control measures,
 - Provisions for responsibility of maintenance, the date the plans were prepared, and the name of the person who prepared them.
