1	SP-2 and SP-3 and P-13	<p>Question: Since two different people will fill out the bid item sheets and the Subcontractor Listing form, is it acceptable to submit the contract documents in a three-ring binder or it is acceptable to staple a copy of the executed Subcontractor Listing form to the original Subcontractors Listing form in the contract document booklet.</p> <p>Answer: The Subcontractors Listing form (P-13) can be removed from the bound contract documents booklet, executed, and replaced/rebound into the booklet. It is also acceptable to copy the Subcontractors Listing form, execute it, and attach the executed form to the original Subcontractors Listing form in the contract booklet by staples or other means.</p>
2	SP-137	<p>Question: I wanted to find out if Cured-In-Place liner would be allowed as an alternate for the Plastic Pipeliner on this project?</p> <p>Answer: Bidders are advised to bid this item per Section 10-1.31 "Existing Highway Facilities" subsection "Plastic Pipeliner".</p>
