		Answer: Contractor's attention is directed to Page C-4 of the Draft Agreement, article 5 for the description of the hours (6 p.m. to 6 a.m.) that constitute a working day for this project.
		Shift work may be considered as long it will allow the work to be completed within the time of the contract, and it will not disrupt daily County functions.
		At the Jail, the County may consider options to get the work completed around the following schedule. The housing units of the jail that are open to the inmates will NOT be accessible overnight from11:00 p.m 6 a.m., additionally the inmate occupied areas will not be available during the following times: Breakfast 6:30 a.m7:15 a.m. Lunch 11:30 a.m12:30 p.m. Dinner 4:30 p.m5:30 p.m. Med's Delivery 5:30 p.m6:00 p.m.
		another will also not be available during these times.

		Answer: Yes, all workers will be required to account for all materials taken into and out of the jail every day.
1.04	N/A	Question: Will cell phones be allowed in the Jail?
		Answer: No, cell phones will not be allowed in the Jail at any time. However, hand held radios will be allowed for the contractor to communicate with their crew.
1.05	N/A	Question: What other security issues are required at the Jail?
		Answer: All personnel of the contractor at the jail must be licensed and properly documented. No one convicted of a felony, or subject to any warrant may enter the jail.
		Escorts must be arranged for moving between all areas within the jail; however escorts may leave the crew once they are setup in a given area. Escorts are not available for moving between areas at the times listed in 1.01 above. It may take 15 minutes to move from one area to another across the jail. Contractor may experience delays do to unforeseen activity within the jail when emergency situations arise.
1.06	N/A	Question: Are tamper proof fixtures required in the jail?
		Answer: Yes, all fixtures shall be secured with tamper proof screws.
1.07	N-1, N-2, C-1, C-2	Question: Will the county supply the tool for use with the existing tamper proof screws?
		Answer: No, as directed in the Contract Documents the contractor must "supply all labor, tools, material and equipment required." County staff indicated that the tool is described as a star diver with a hollow tip.
