Below includes a summary of the discussion at the pre-bid meeting held on Tuesday, January 14, 2014.

ITEM NO.	LOCATION, PAGE OR DRAWING NO.	QUESTION/ANSWER
1.01.	N-1, P-3, and Plan Sheet 4	The project is being re-bid with a change in scope. The scope includes striping removal, slurry seal, re-stripe, install signs, markers, and markings, and place and compact aggregate base for shoulder backing. The quantities for these items were discussed and appear in the bid schedule of the Proposal and on sheet 4 of 4 of the Plans.
1.02.	SP-53	Attention was directed to Chart No. 1 "Two-Lane Conventional Highway Lane Requirements" on SP-53 of the special provisions.
1.03.	SP-5	It was noted that Section 4-1.01 of the special provisions addresses when it is anticipated that the County will issue Notice to Proceed.
1.04.		The deadline for submitting questions before the bid opening is Thursday, January 16, 2014 at 10:00 a.m.
