CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

The District Attorney of El Dorado County, based upon information and belief, hereby alleges:

COUNT 1

On or about the 30th day of November, 2006, in the County of El Dorado, the crime of of **WILLFUL, DELIBERATE, PREMEDITATED MURDER**, in violation of **PENAL CODE SECTION 187(a)**, a Felony, was committed by ERIC TODD MEHLMAUER, who did unlawfully and with malice aforethought murder Tobias Allen Kaiser, a human being.

It is further alleged that the aforesaid murder was committed willfully, deliberately and with premeditation within the meaning of Penal Code section 664(a) and is a serious felony pursuant to Penal Code section 1192.7(c).

“NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c).”

“NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require you to provide specimens and samples pursuant to Penal Code section 296. Willful refusal to provide the specimens and samples is a crime.”

**SPECIAL ALLEGATION - PRINCIPAL'S INTENTIONAL DISCHARGE
OF A FIREARM, GBI OR DEATH**

It is further alleged as to Count 1 that said ERIC TODD MEHLMAUER personally and intentionally discharged a firearm, which caused great bodily injury of death to TOBIAS KAISER within the meaning of Penal Code Sections 12022.53(d) also causing the above offense

to become a serious felony pursuant to Penal Code Section 1192.7(c)(8) and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 667.5(c)(8).

It is further alleged that said ERIC TODD MEHLMAUER personally and intentionally discharged a firearm, within the meaning of Penal Code Sections 12022.53(c) also causing the above offense to become a serious felony pursuant to Penal Code Section 1192.7(c)(8) and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 667.5(c)(8).

It is further alleged that said ERIC TODD MEHLMAUER personally used a firearm within the meaning of Penal Code Sections 12022.53(b) also causing the above offense to become a serious felony pursuant to Penal Code Section 1192.7(c)(8) and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 667.5(c)(8).


COUNT 2

On or about and between the 30th day of November, 2006 and the 15th day of January, 2015 in the County of El Dorado, the crime of ACCESSORY AFTER THE FACT, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 32, a Felony, was committed by RONALD ANTHONY GARCIA, who did willfully and unlawfully, having knowledge that the crime of Murder, a felony, in violation of Section 187 of the Penal Code of the State of California had been committed by ERIC MEHLMAUER, did harbor, conceal, and aid said ERIC MEHLMAUER, with the intent that he/she might avoid and escape from arrest, trial, conviction, and punishment for said felony.

Based upon information and belief, the undersigned certifies in his/her official capacity and under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct and that this declaration was executed on the date stated below at El Dorado County, California.
