Registrar of Voters mailing postcards to unaffiliated voters

On April 13th the Registrar of Voters will mailed over 15,000 salmon-colored postcards to voters whose party affiliation is indicated as "No Party Preference" (formerly known as Decline to State voters prior to the passage of Proposition 14) and who will vote by mail in the June 7th Presidential Primary Election.

The postcards will ask these voters what type of ballot they would like to be mailed for the election.

Three political parties will allow voters in this category to vote their party's ballots. They are the Democratic Party, American Independent Party and Libertarian. Selection of one of these party's ballots will allow the No Party Preference voter to cast a vote for one of that party's presidential primary candidates.

No Party Preference voters also have the option to vote strictly a non-partisan ballot without a presidential primary contest on it.

No Party Preference voters are requested to return the pre-paid postcard to the Registrar of Voters by April 22nd in order to receive the selected ballot in a timely manner. Selection of a party ballot does not change the voter's current registration.

To cast your vote in the Republican, Green and Peace and Freedom Party Primary you must register with that party by May 23rd.

Dear Registered Voter:

In the June 7, 2016 Consolidated Presidential Primary Election, California voters who registered without declaring a qualified political party preference will receive a non-partisan ballot that does not contain any party's primary candidates for President; or they may choose to cast the ballot of a political party whose party rules allow it. For this election, participating parties include the Democratic Party, American Independent Party and Libertarian Party whose ballots will include the party's primary candidate(s) for President.

Our records indicate that you: (1) registered without designating a qualified political party preference; and (2) are either a permanent vote by mail voter or reside in a mail ballot precinct. You are scheduled to receive a non-partisan ballot in your mail after May 9, 2016. If you plan to vote the non-partisan ballot, no further action is required of you.

If you desire to receive and vote a party ballot (Democratic, American Independent or Libertarian), you must indicate which party's ballot you choose on the reverse side of this card – you may choose only one – and mail it back to the Elections Department. This will not change your current voter registration, which will remain without a qualified political party preference until you register again. We must receive your response by April 22, 2016 in order to provide you with the ballot of your choice in a timely manner.
