1. Grants

- a. Waste Tire Amnesty Grant: Events take place on the third Saturday of each month at both the EDD and STR MRF's until the grant term ends (4/15/2017) or funds are exhausted (whichever occurs first). Collection of residential waste tires 24" in diameter or smaller (off the rim).
 - i. First event – just under 750 waste tires were collected by EDD.
- b. City/County Payment Program Grant Awarded: Supports Roadside Litter Abatement Program funding.
- c. Oil Payment Program 6 Grant Awarded: Supports HHW and used Oil collection program.
- d. Household Hazardous Waste Grant: Supports signs, safety, and security for the HHW events in El Dorado Hills.
