EDSWAC' Operation Guidelines:

1. Use data to monitor the status of existing diversion practices/strategies, and to identify and recommend the next best steps to further increase diversion up to 75%. Data to be used in this process include: **a)** strategies identified in the Solid Waste Management Plan; **b)** annual Source Reduction Report organized by Paris codes; **c)** construction and demolition (C&D) diversion for appropriate building permits and percentage of C&D tons diverted; and **d)** quarterly jurisdiction reports on diversion.
2. Identify opportunities and strategies for increasing public participation and education about reducing, reusing, recycling and recovering materials to reduce the waste stream entering material recovery facilities.
3. Seek out and review strategies for waste diversion used successfully by other jurisdictions.
