Provided for your information and consideration, the following are approved pole lighting heights for the Missouri Flat Road and Forni Road vicinity commercial projects.

1. Walmart, Z94-0008, PD94-0002
Approved by BOS December 15, 1998
30-foot tall pole lights.
2. Schools Financial, PD03-0008
Approved by PC April 8, 2004
18-foot tall pole lights.
3. Golden Center Plaza, PD03-0006
Approved by BOS June 7, 2005
Up to 25-foot tall pole lights.
- ** Missouri Flat Design Guidelines Adopted by BOS June 3, 2008. (Page 3.43 of the Missouri Flat Design Guidelines state the following: *The height of a light pole should be appropriately scaled to the building or complex and the surrounding area. Pedestrian light poles along sidewalks or pathways and parking lot light standards should be 10 to 15 feet high unless bollards are used. Light poles, standards, and fixtures within parking areas should be between 10 and 15 feet in height.*)
4. Walgreens, PD08-0001
Approved by BOS October 21, 2008
Up to 30-foot tall pole lights. (Note: This project was deemed complete February 4, 2008 and was not subject to the Missouri Flat Design Guidelines.)
5. Panda Express, PD09-0001
Approved by PC September 10, 2009
15-foot tall pole lights.
