- The permit's 2011 unsecured property tax bill must be paid.
- 2012 Concessions Contract from the California Dept. of Parks and Recreation.
- Letter of authorization for all private land parcels used by your company.
- Bureau of Land Management permit for lunch stops or camping on public lands.
- Documentation that guides have swiftwater rescue training that meets County standards.
- Water flow notice in brochure or booking confirmation package.

Company owners, representatives and employees must comply with the outfitter regulations in the El Dorado County River Management Plan. I certify that all statements and answers are true and complete. I understand any falsification may result in rejection of this application or forfeiture of the permit.

OPTIONAL – 2012 RIVER ACCESS AT HENNINGSEN LOTUS PARK

El Dorado County allows permitted outfitters to use Henningsen Lotus Park for river access under the following conditions:

Use Regulations:

1. Commercial vehicle parking for raft trips is restricted to 15 minutes loading and unloading of passengers and equipment.
👉 **Commercial vehicles may not be left unattended.**
2. Outfitters must use the boat ramp area to load and unload rafts.
3. Lunch stops by commercial raft trips are not allowed at the park.
4. Lunch stops by kayak instruction classes are allowed on a space available basis.
5. Commercial trips may stop to use the restroom facilities (no fees).

Fees:

1. Commercial put-in and take-out fee rate is:

\$9.00 per raft

\$3.00 per kayak

2. Fees must be paid when the Monthly Operating Report is submitted. Submit a **separate check**, payable to El Dorado County, for access fees at the County Park (access fees are deposited into the Henningsen-Lotus Park account).
3. Outfitters using the park for kayak classes are required to obtain a \$40.00 annual parking pass. This pass allows kayak outfitters to park a vehicle in the parking lot throughout the day while classes are taught.

Check the above box to indicate you want a kayak instruction parking pass.

Please enclose a separate check in the amount of \$40.00, payable to El Dorado County, with your permit application

The term of this authorization begins April 1, 2012 (or the date your permit is renewed and ends March 31, 2013).
