Please accept this memo as a weekly update to the activities surrounding the County of El Dorado's recovery from the Mosquito Fire as managed by the Recovery Operations Center's (ROC) co-directors Sgt. Moke Auwae and me.

Environmental Management

- ROE universe is 22. We have received 19.
- Permitted Structures (12 ROEs expected):
 - 10 ROEs received
 - 7 approved
 - 2 are waiting on corrections
- Other Structures (unpermitted dwellings & outbuildings. 10 ROEs expected):
 - 9 received
 - 8 approved
 - 1 is waiting on corrections
- Vehicles:
 - 36 noted on ROEs
 - 7 have been requested by owners to be excluded (they will deal with the vehicle disposition themselves)

Land Use

- Going to Board of Supervisors with Urgency Ordinance Jan. 3rd

Health and Human Services Agency

- **Social Worker**
 - Continuing to provide support to a survivor in the HDAP program
- **Mental Health Worker**
 - Continues to provide support groups to survivors
 - Working with a survivor on receiving Behavioral Health Services
