Environmental Management – No Update From Prior Week

- ROE universe is 22 & 19 have been received
- Permitted Structures:
 - 12 ROEs expected / 10 ROEs received / 7 approved / 2 are waiting on corrections
- Other Structures (unpermitted dwellings & outbuildings):
 - 10 ROEs expected / 9 received / 8 approved / 1 is waiting on corrections
- Vehicles:
 - 36 noted on ROEs / 7 have been requested by owners to be excluded (they will deal with the vehicle disposition themselves)
