Please accept this memo as a weekly update to the activities surrounding the County of El Dorado's recovery from the Mosquito Fire as managed by the Recovery Operations Center's (ROC) co-directors Sgt. Moke Auwae and me.

### Environmental Management

- ROE universe is 22 & 19 have been received
- Permitted Structures:
  - 12 ROEs expected / 10 ROEs received / 9 approved / 1 is waiting on corrections
  - 2 parcels have not submitted an ROE – EMD contacted one on 1/5/2023 and should receive it next week. The second owner's contact information is being researched.
- Other Structures (unpermitted dwellings & outbuildings):
  - 10 ROEs expected / 9 received / 9 approved
- Vehicles:
  - 36 noted on ROEs / 7 have been requested by owners to be excluded (they will deal with the vehicle disposition themselves)
