## **Attention Residents of El Dorado County Impacted by the Mosquito Fire**

Starting the week of October 3<sup>rd</sup>, The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) and PARC Specialty will be conducting the mandatory Phase 1 hazardous materials assessments of all properties that were impacted by the Mosquito Fire. DTSC and PARC Specialty will be identifying and removing household hazardous waste, asbestos-containing material, and e-waste from the impacted parcels. Residents do not need to be present during the Phase 1 operation at their property. This service is free to all affected property owners due to the local health emergency declarations by the El Dorado County Public Health Officer and Governor Gavin Newsom. Once the Phase 1 team has completed their objectives at your property, your parcel will be posted with a notice of completion of all Phase 1 activities.

We do not know if the State will offer additional property debris cleanup. However, if they do offer the program, one of criteria for inclusion into the program is that the ash footprint isn't disturbed. If you have any questions, feel free to visit the Mosquito Fire Recovery website at:
